

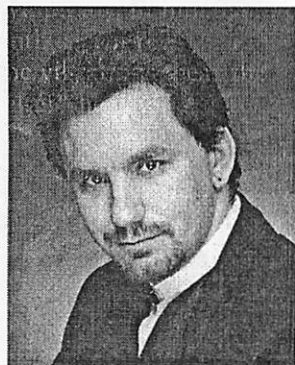
Paul Roby, violin soloist, knew by age 10, that he wanted to be a musician. Encouraged by his family to pursue a career in music, by the time he was 16, Paul's talent led him to Philadelphia's Curtis Institute of Music. There he founded the Salzau Quartet, and toured extensively through Europe. After graduating from Curtis, Paul played with the Baltimore and National Symphony orchestras, but his dream was always to become a member of the Philadelphia Orchestra. In 1991, his dream came true. He



was appointed Associate Principal Second Violin, of the Philadelphia Orchestra, and a front-row chair. A frequently invited guest soloist, Paul recently played a concert with his dad, also a violinist named Paul Roby, with the Terre Haute Symphony, in Indiana.

When he plays for an audience, Paul Roby's enthusiasm is immediate. "At a live performance, you can feel the vibrations, hear the sounds – a combination you can't find anywhere else!" he says.

Gabriel Gordon, conductor, is the Music Director of numerous Youth, Community, and professional orchestras in the tri-state area. These orchestras include the greater Newark youth Orchestra, the Old York Road Symphony, and The Independence Sinfonia.



Reviews have been unanimous, as Classical New Jersey and many others say, "Watching and listening to the maestro lead the orchestra is a treat in itself. Every gesture has a clear purpose; is significantly nuanced and is explicitly observed by the musicians. even the uninitiated couldn't fail to understand the maestro's direction."

Mr. Gordon has also conducted the Atlanta Symphony, and will lead the New Jersey Symphony later this year in a side-by-side concert with the Greater Newark Youth Orchestra. Guest conducting has included many ensembles from New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, and Israel.



Jeffrey Bradbury is in his first year as Assistant Conductor of the Independence Sinfonia. Mr. Bradbury is a graduate of West Chester University and a recent addition to the faculty of the Kingsway Regional School District conducting Middle School and High School Orchestra. He is currently pursuing a Masters Degree in Conducting from Rowan University.
